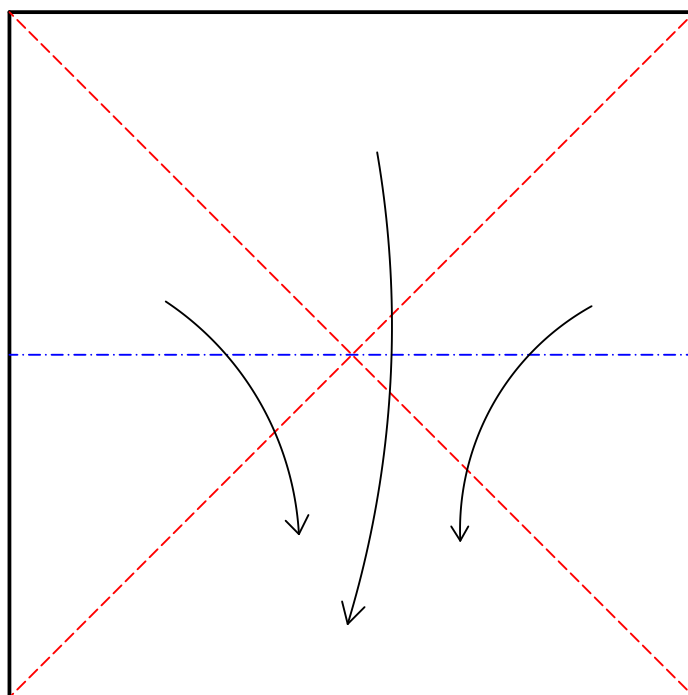


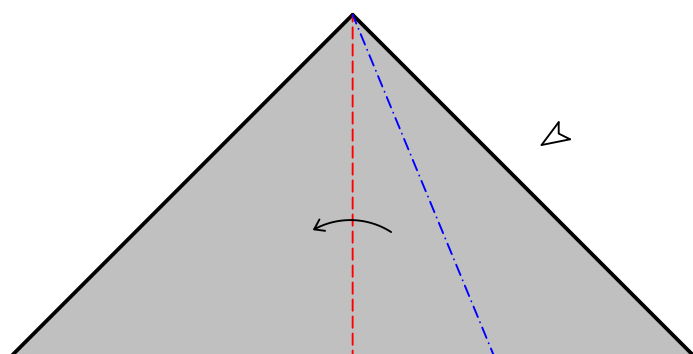
Berone Sunrise - (c) Martin Hunt 2013

Folding time approx 15-20 minutes

Start with a square, coloured side down

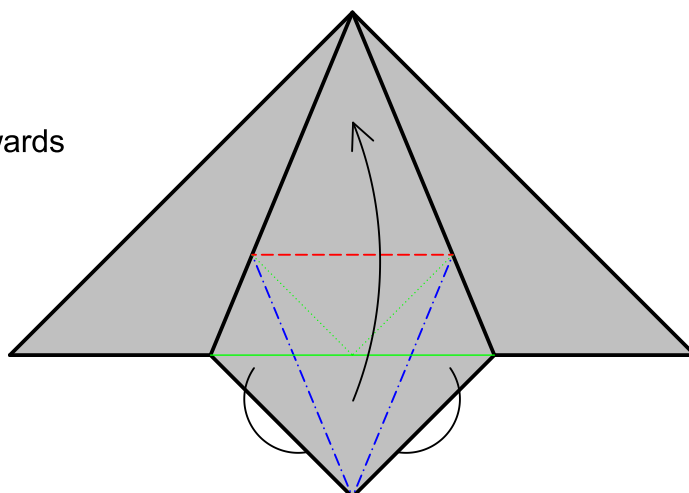


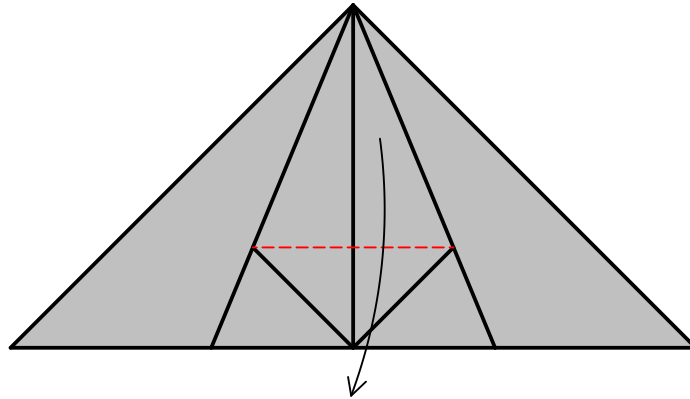
1. Fold a waterbomb base



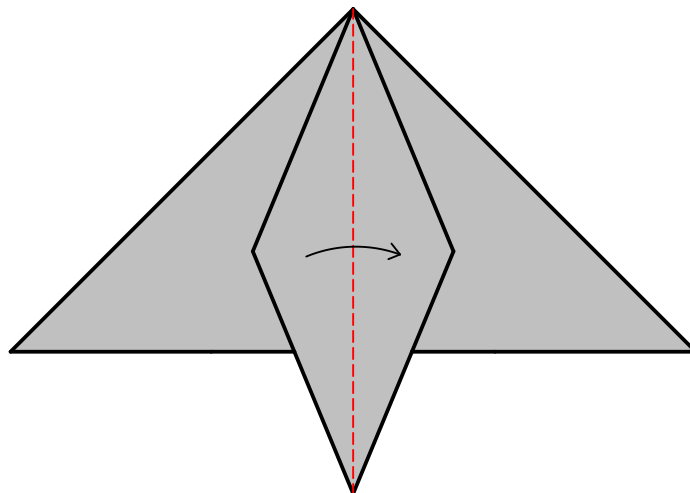
2. Squash fold one flap

3. Petal fold flap upwards

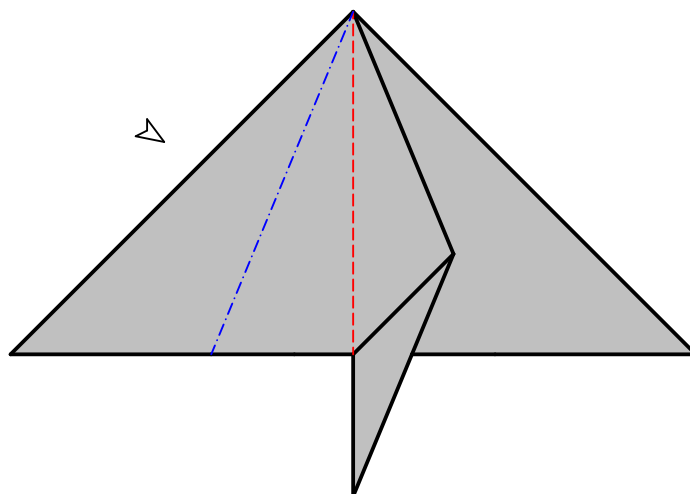




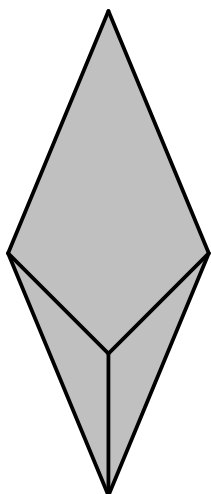
4. Fold flap back down



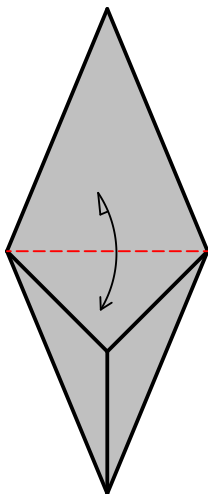
5. Fold one flap to the right



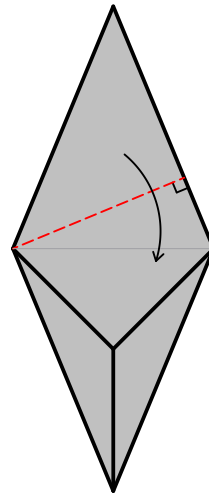
6. Repeat steps 2-5 on the remaining three flaps



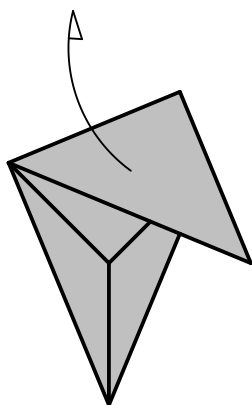
7. Like so



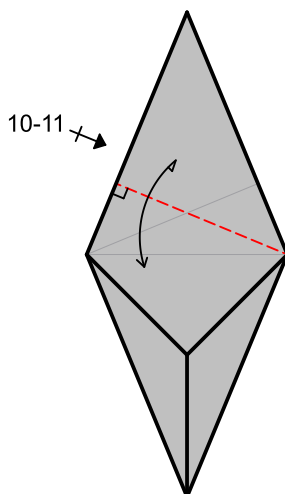
8. Fold the thick top flap down.
Crease firmly through all layers
then unfold



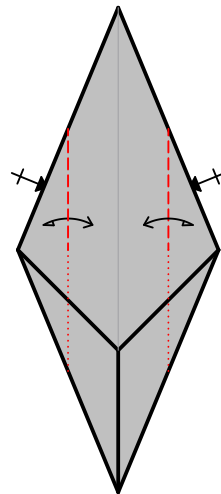
10. Fold perpendicular
to the right edge



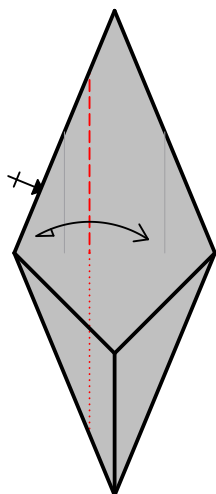
11. Like so.
Unfold to step 10



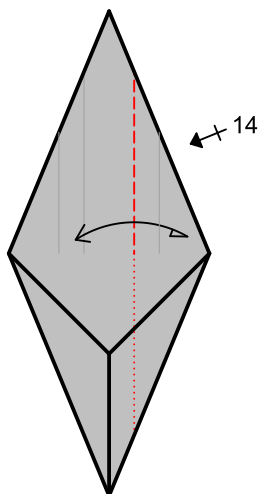
12. Repeat steps 10-11
on the left hand side



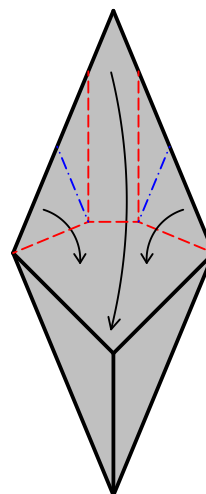
13. Fold two layers to the centre line.
and unfold
Crease only the top of the model.
Repeat behind



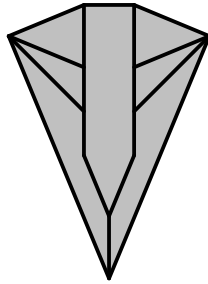
14. Fold two layers to the crease
made in the previous step
and unfold.
Crease only the top of the model.
Repeat behind



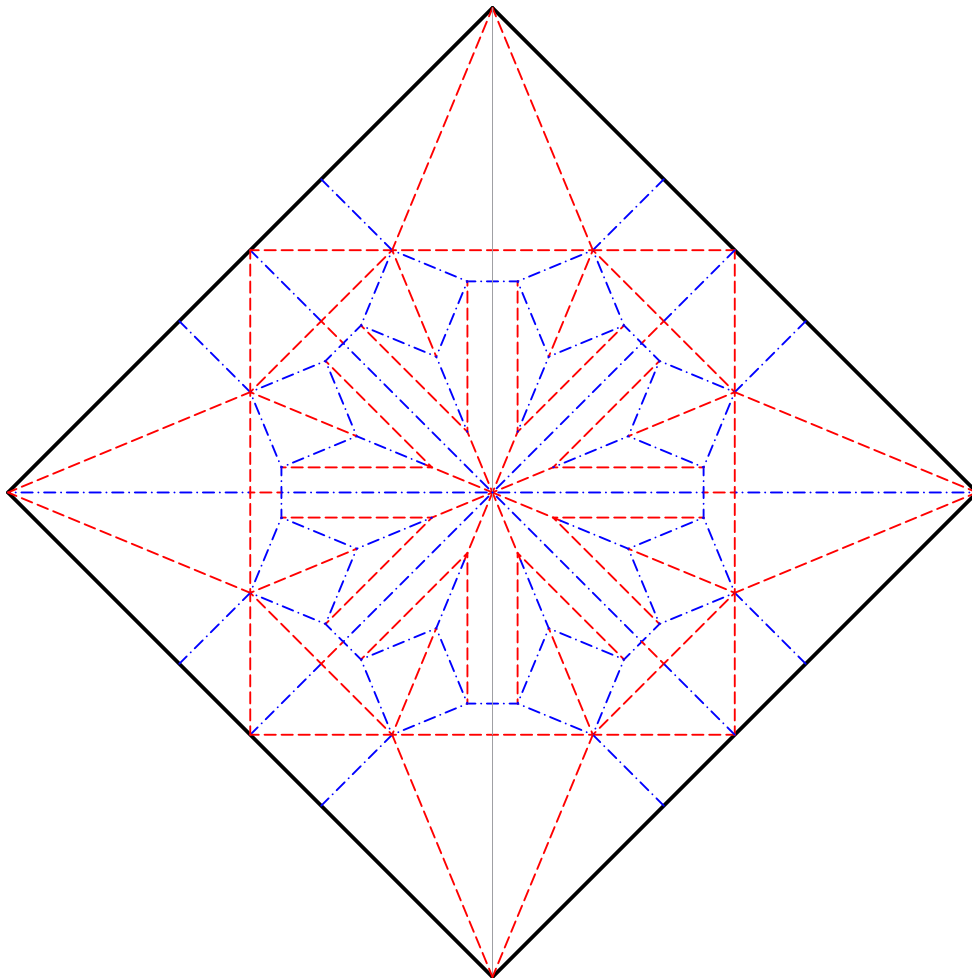
15. Repeat step 14
on the right



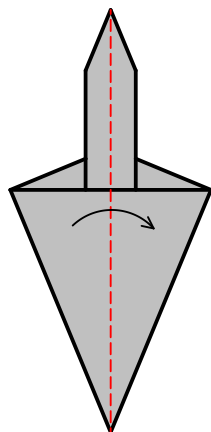
16. Double rabbit ear
the top flap.
The valley folds lie on existing creases



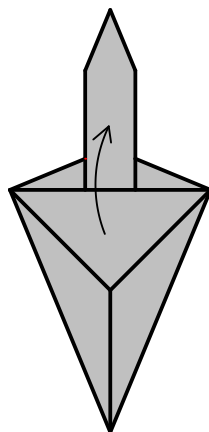
17. Like so.
Unfold the model completely



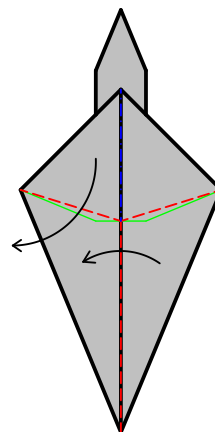
18. Refold the base, sinking the narrow tip into the centre of the model.
All creases already exist, but some will need their direction reversing.
This step can be a little tricky, so take your time.
Start by ensuring each crease is in the correct direction
then slowly and gently collapse the model



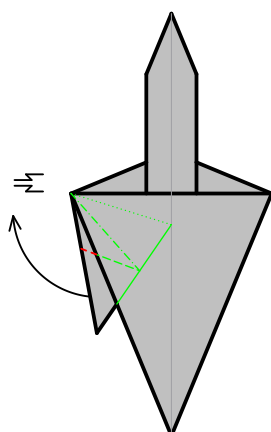
19. Fold one layer to the right



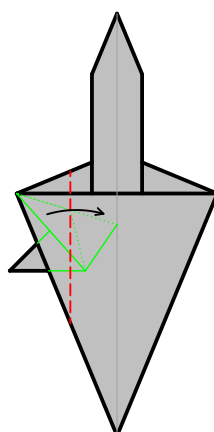
20. Fold the small flap up releasing any trapped layers



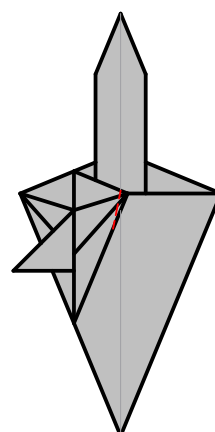
21. Fold the flap back to the left incorporating the reverse fold shown



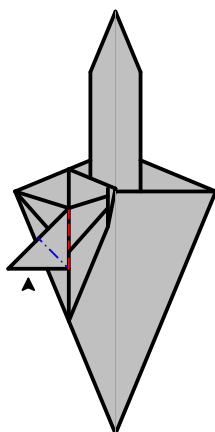
22. Crimp the flap upwards so that the bottom edge lies horizontally



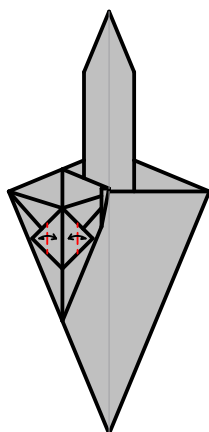
23. Like so. Valley fold one layer to the right as far as it will go



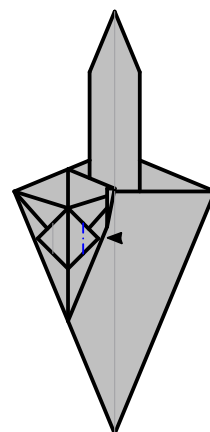
24. Like so. Fold the portion of the flap overlapping the centre line so that the right edge lies vertical



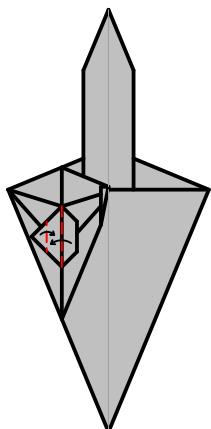
25. Squash fold the small flap



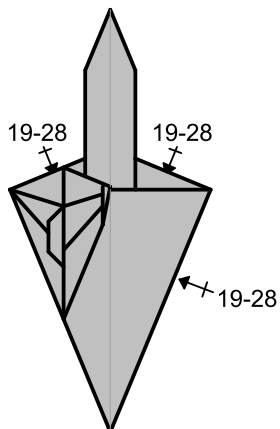
26. Fold and unfold



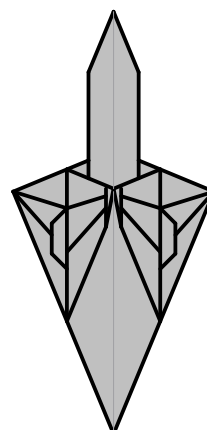
27. Reverse fold the right side on the existing crease



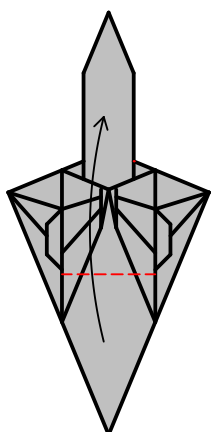
28. Fold to the left tucking the small flap into the pocket created by the previous step



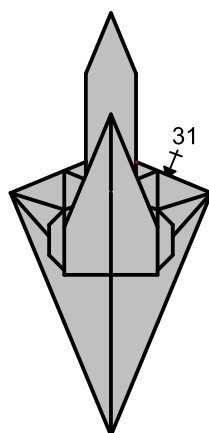
29. Repeat steps 19-28 on the right and behind



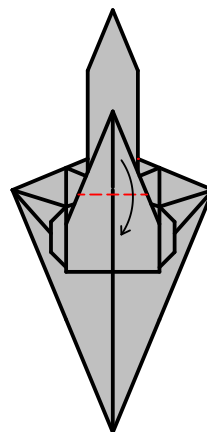
30. Like so



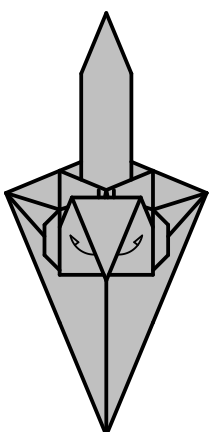
31. Fold the flap up



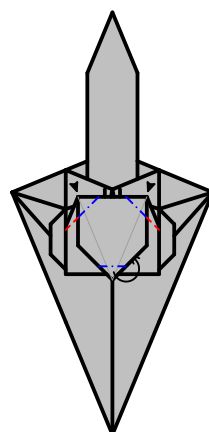
32. Like so. Repeat step 31 behind



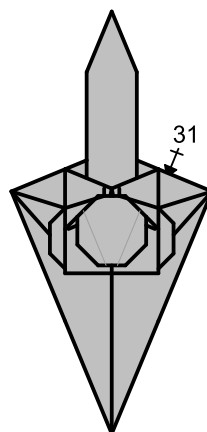
33. Fold down. The tip should extend just past the horizontal edge



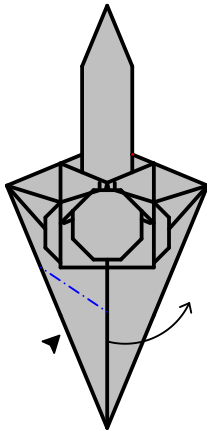
34. Pull out some of the trapped paper on each side



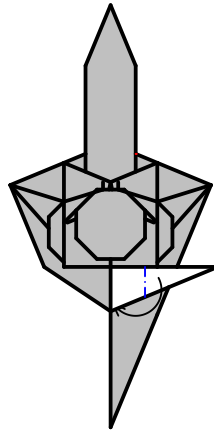
35. Reverse fold the top two corners. Mountain fold the bottom of the flap



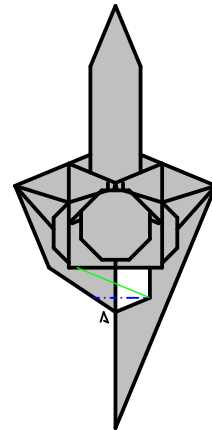
36. Like so. Repeat steps 33-35 behind



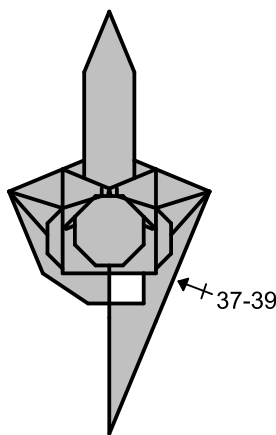
37. Reverse fold between the first and second layers



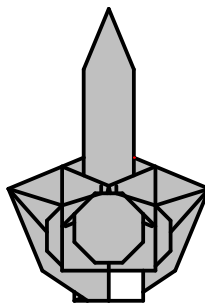
38. Mountain fold the tip behind



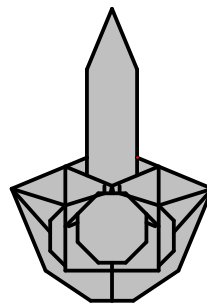
39. Reverse fold in line with the hidden edge



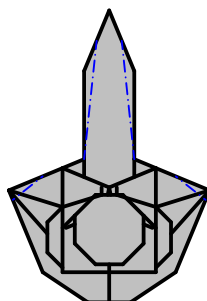
40. Repeat steps 37-39 on the right



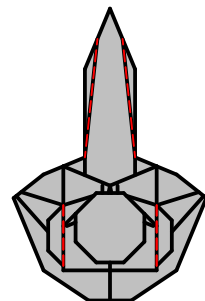
41. Tuck the white tab into the pocket of the other flap in front and behind



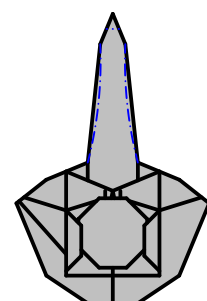
42. Like so. The gap between the two flaps should now be closed



43. Mountain fold the top layers of the nose inside. and the edges of the body. Repeat behind



44. Valley fold the second layers of the nose inside. Fold the small rectangular flaps in. Repeat behind



45. Add final shaping to the nose. The model is now complete
